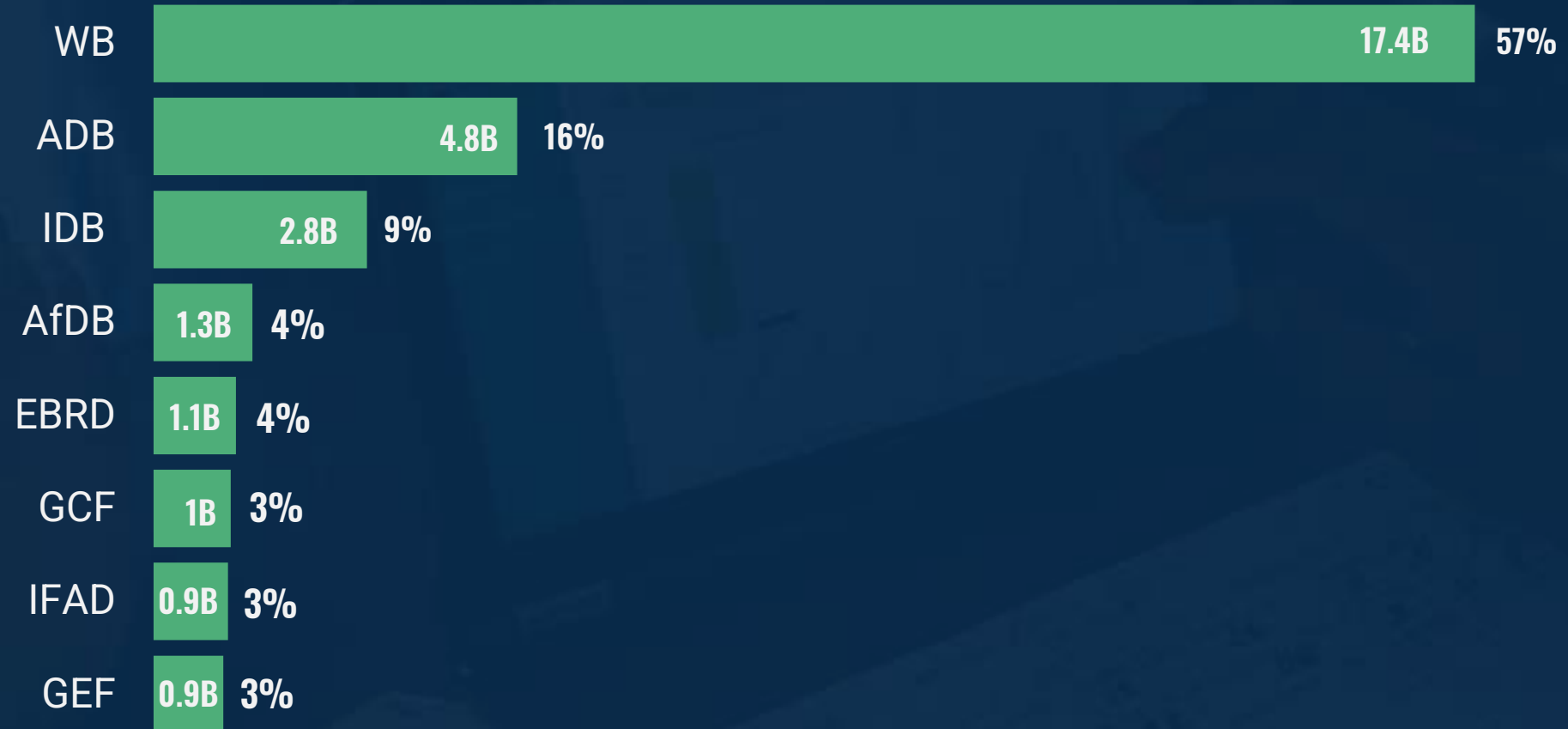

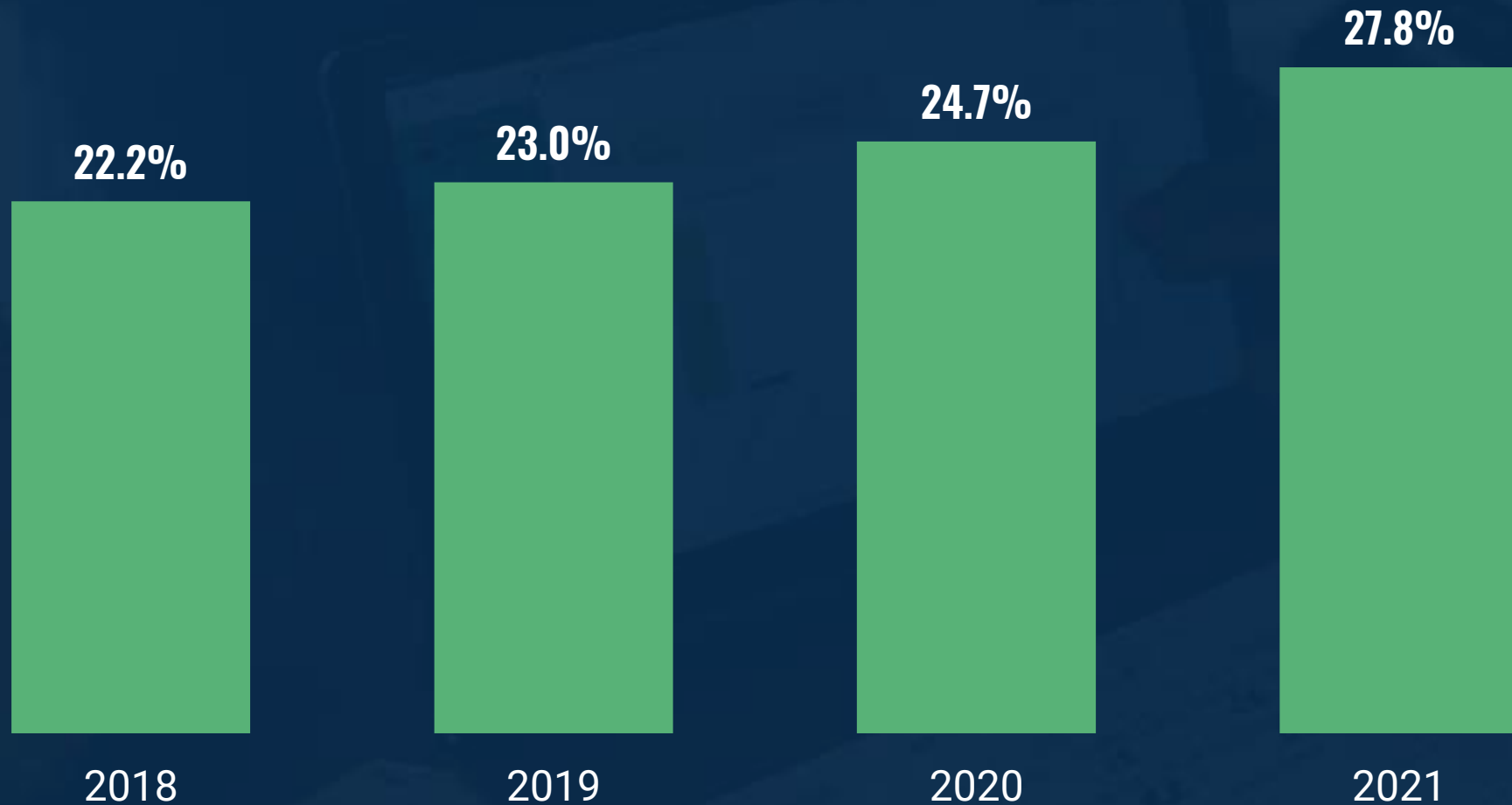

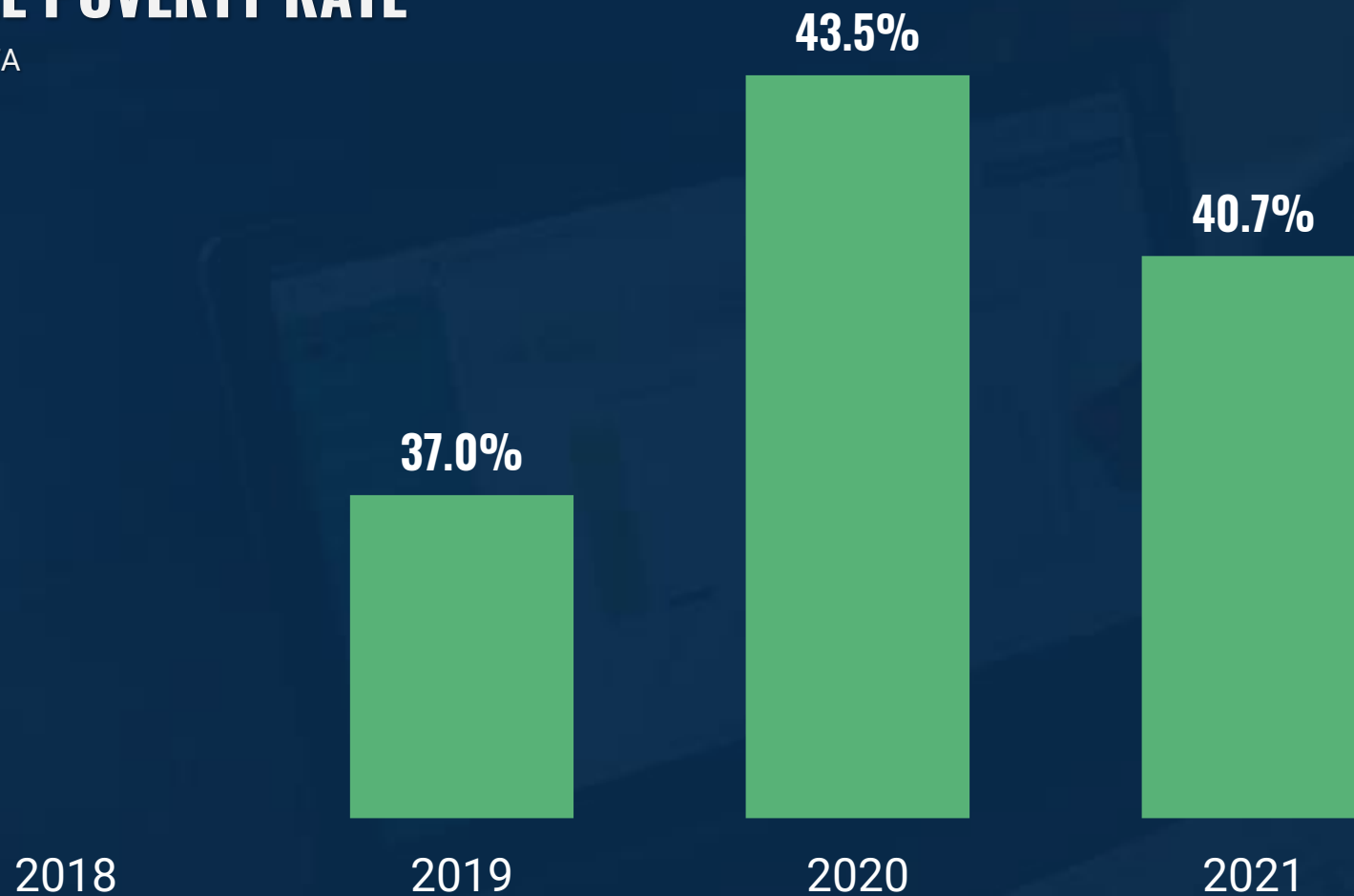

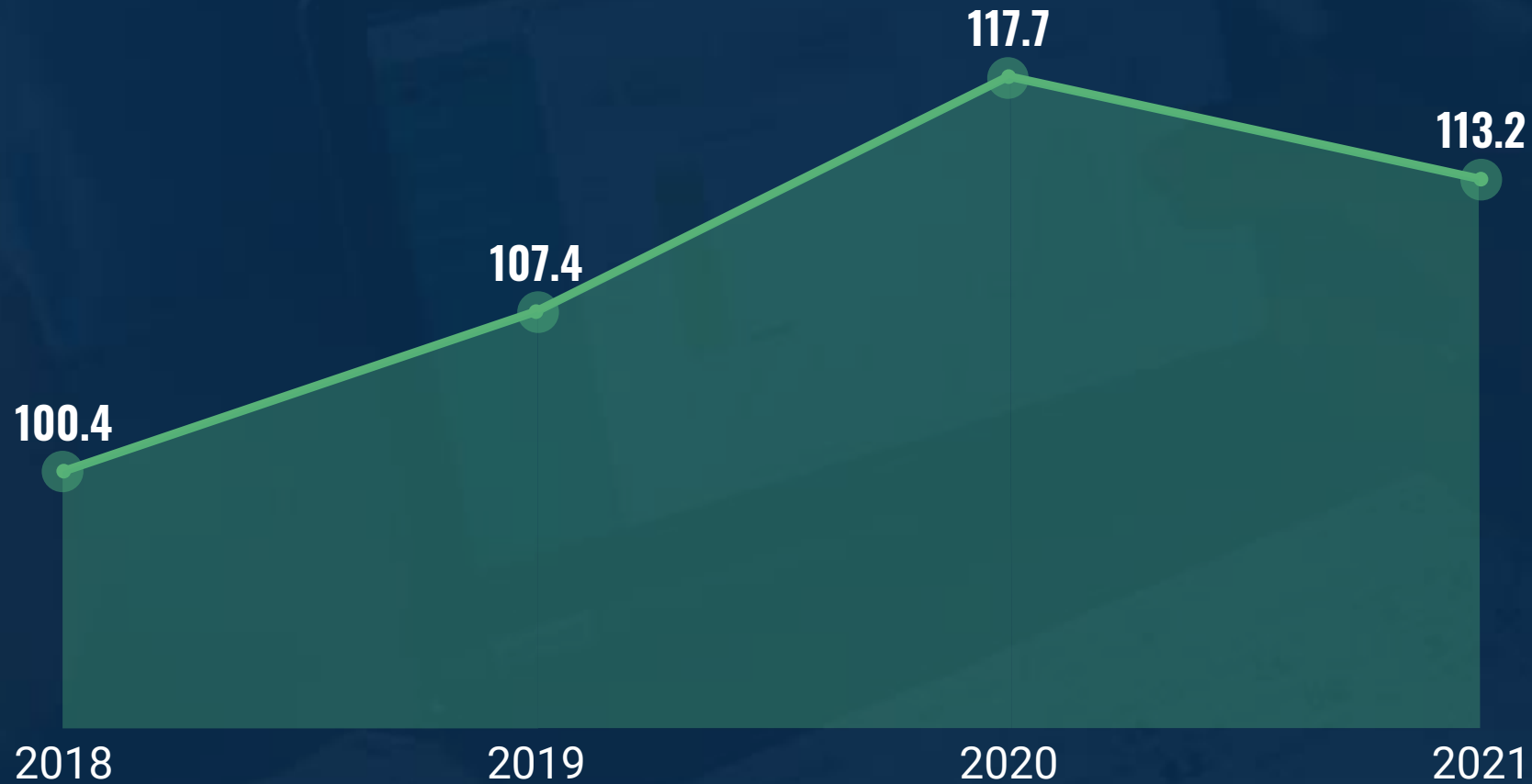

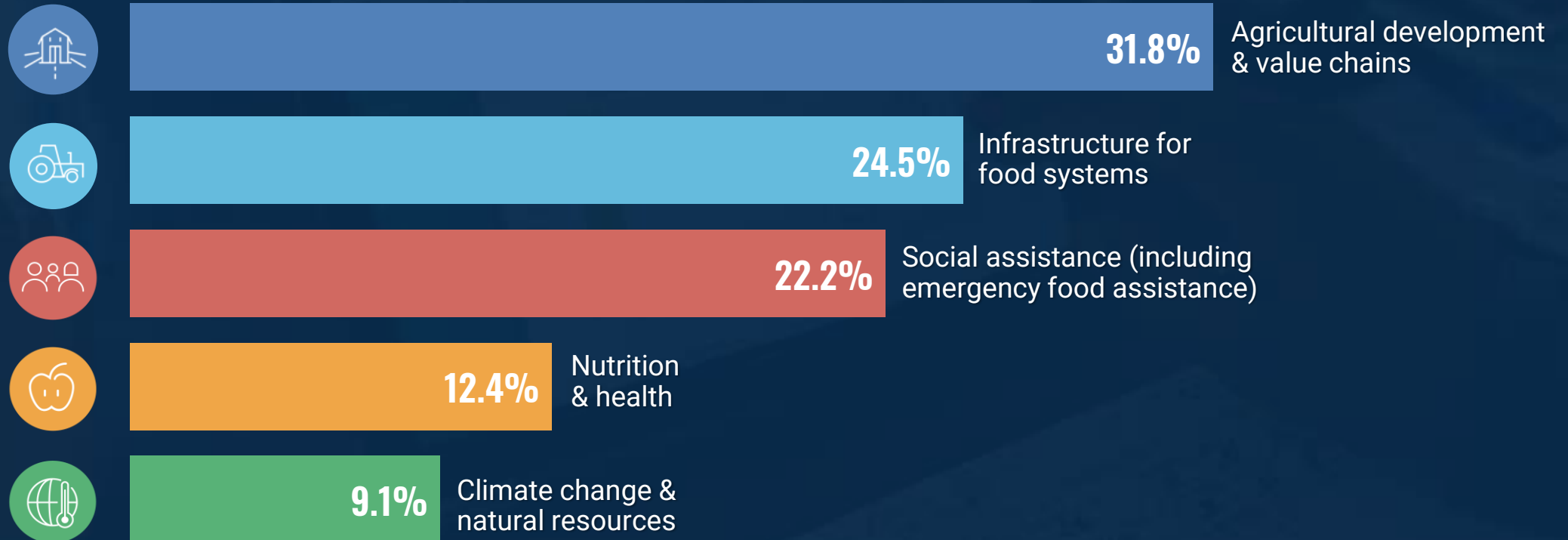

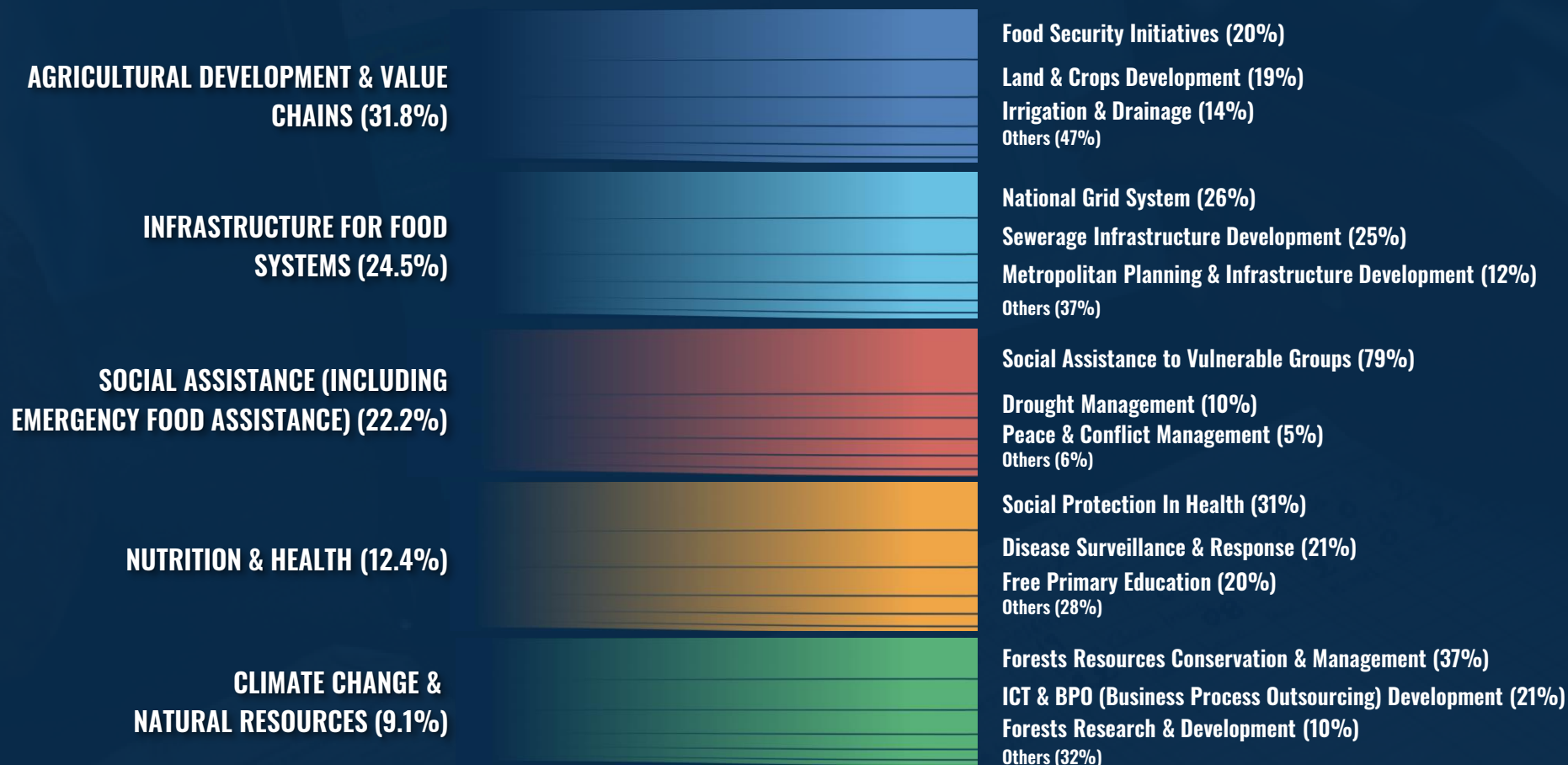

3. BREAKDOWN OF GOVERNMENT SPENDING ACROSS FOOD SYSTEMS COMPONENTS

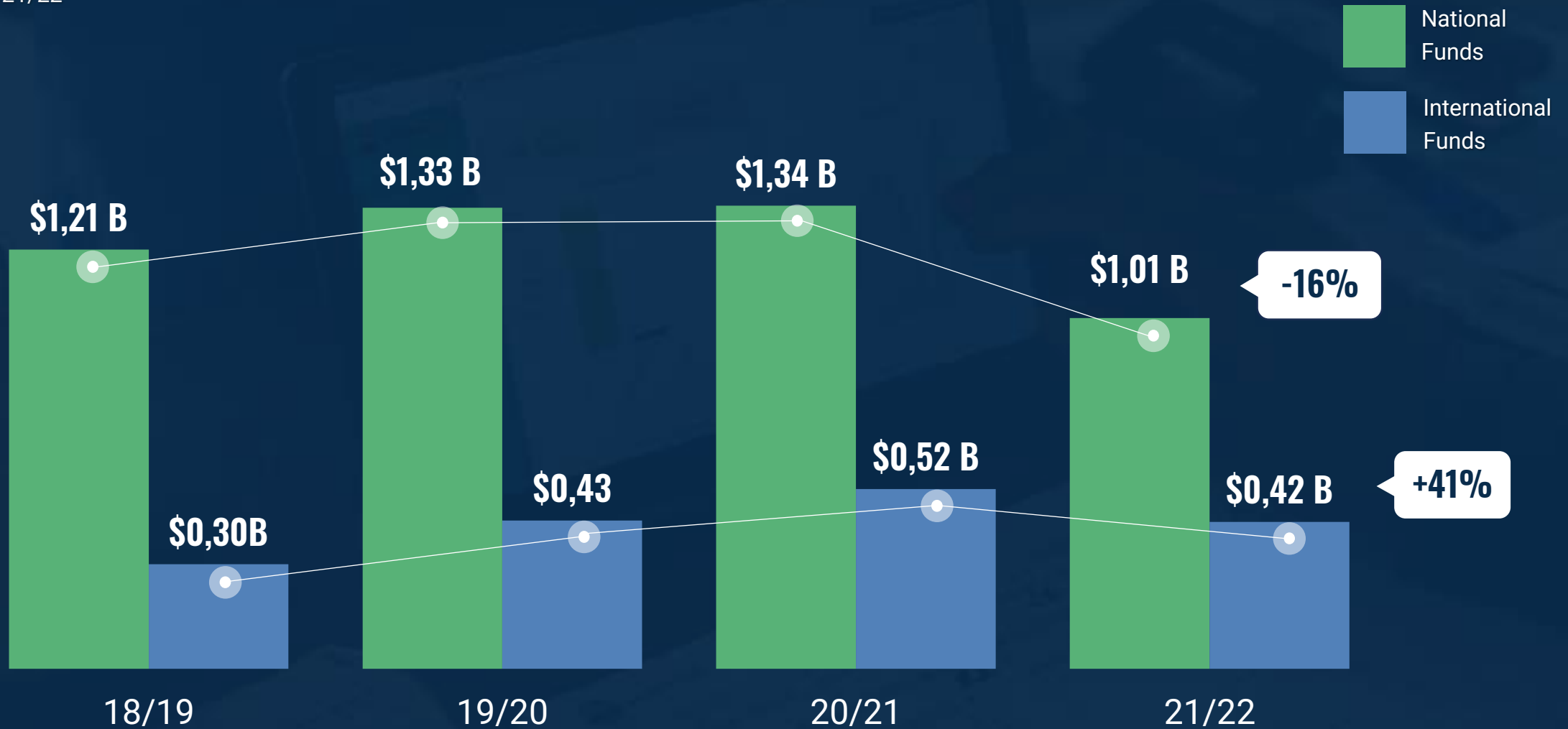

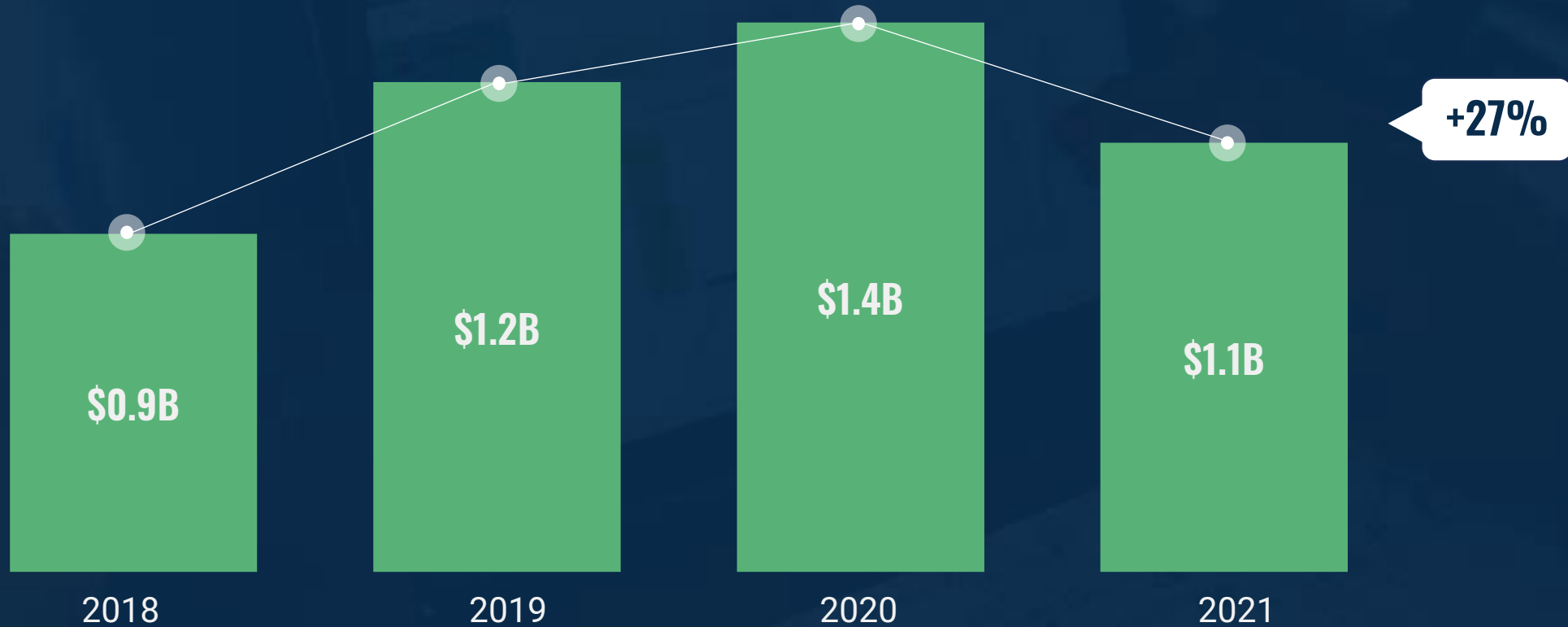

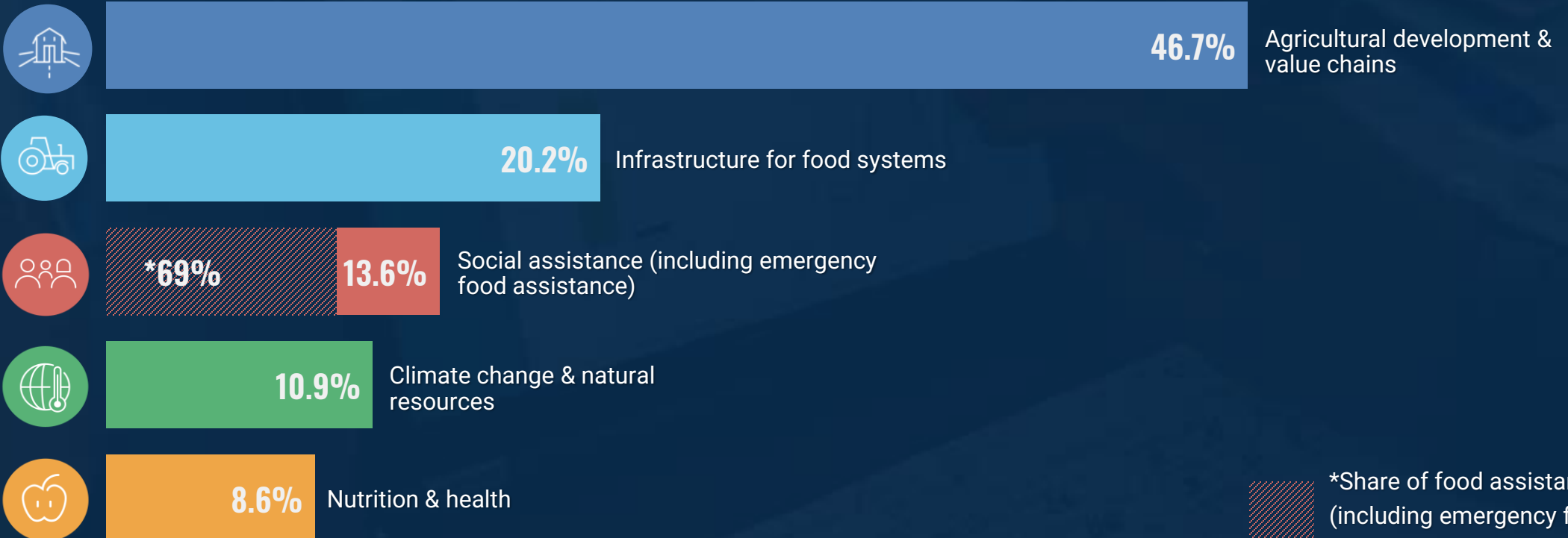

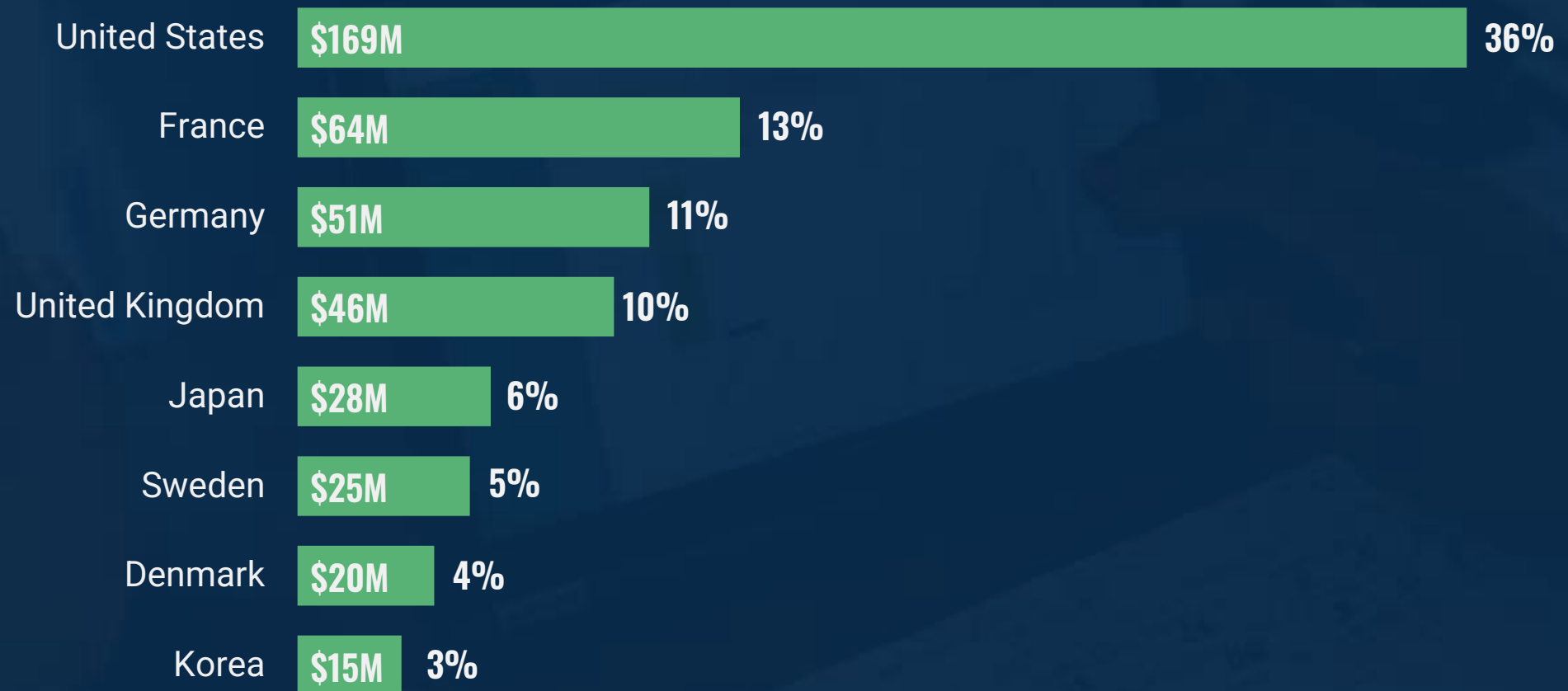

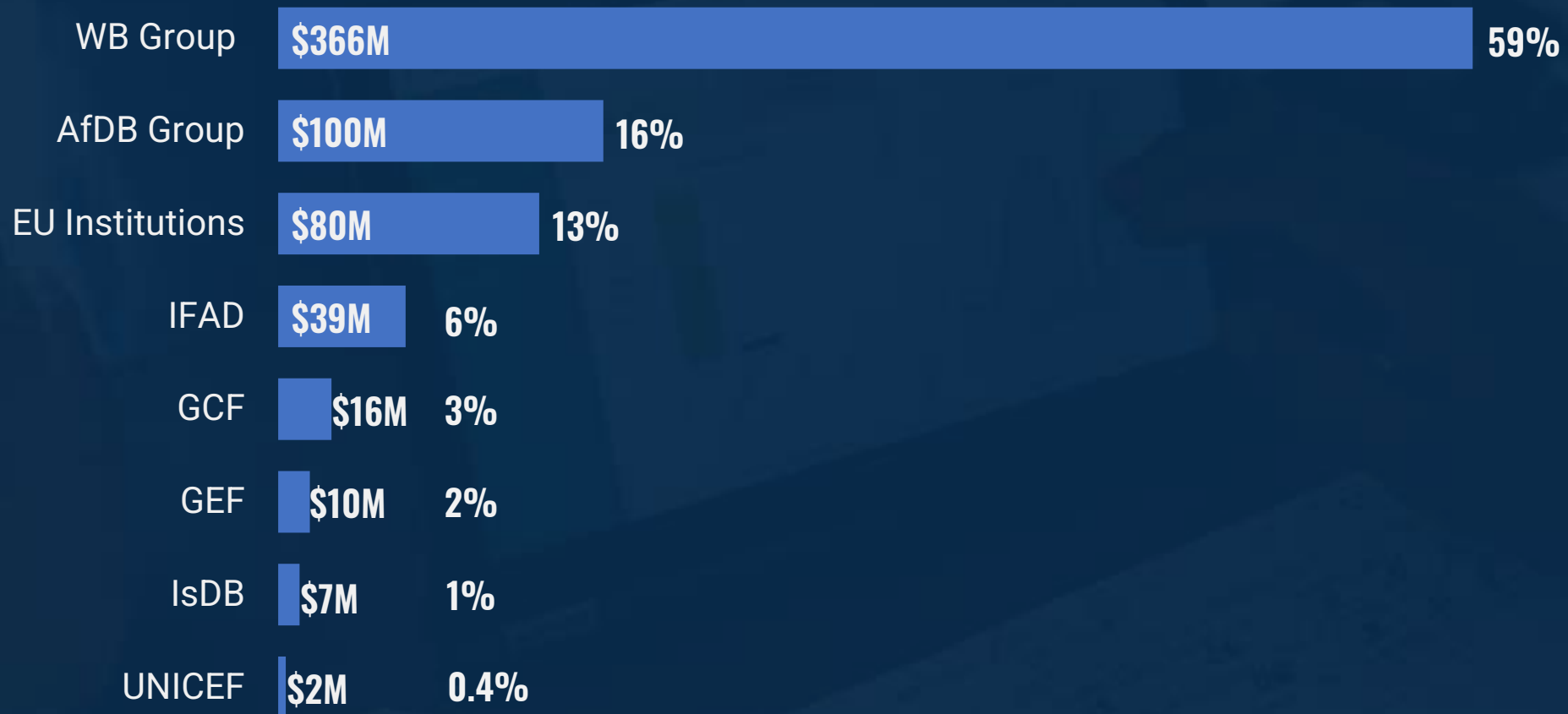
